Press Release: Handing over of medical supplies to Bhutan

Government of India is pleased to respond to the request from the Royal Government of Bhutan for provision of medical supplies in the wake of the outbreak of COVID-19. The first consignment of medical supplies comprising surgical masks, surgical gloves, head covers, shoe covers and hand sanitizers was handed over by the Ambassador of India, Ms. Ruchira Kamboj to Hon'ble Minister of Health of Bhutan, Lyonpo Dechen Wangmo in a ceremony held at the Ministry of Health, Royal Government of Bhutan on 23 March 2020.
