Press Release: 3rd India-Bhutan High Impact Community Development Project Committee meeting

The third meeting of the India-Bhutan High Impact Community Development Project (HICDP) Committee between the Government of India and the Royal Government of Bhutan took place on 6 May 2020 in Thimphu.
