The Bhutanese select group has elected to proceed on a 7-day Wildlife Tour of Madhya Pradesh that will cover Jabalpur, Bhedaghat, Bandhavgarh National Park, Kanha National Park, Pench Wildlife Sanctuary and other attractions. The group will have the opportunity to see Royal Bengal Tigers, White Tigers, leopards, deer and a variety of bird species including eagles in their natural habitats.

4. Speaking at the event, Ambassador Ruchira Kamboj said, “Madhya Pradesh is the heart of India and offers a beautiful mix of nature, heritage, wildlife and spirituality.
