Government of India releases Rs./Nu. 64.94 Crore to GNHC

- Mr. S. Koventhan, First Secretary (Eco & Com), Indian Embassy, handed over cheques amounting to Rs. /Nu. 64.94 Crore to Mr. Penjore, Sr. Program Coordinator, GNHC on 28th March 2018.
- 2. This release of funds of worth Rs./Nu. 64.94 Crore will fund (1) Conservation of Trashigang Dzong (3) Royal Institute of Governance and Strategic Studies (RIGSS) and (3) 19th Installment of Development Subsidy (Programme Grant) for the period January March 2018
- 3. Government of India has committed Nu. 5000 Crore in the 11th FYP to Royal Government of Bhutan. The detailed break-up of the commitment is: Rs./Nu. 2800 Crore for Project Tied Assistance (PTA), Rs./Nu. 850 Crore for Small Development Projects (SDP), Rs./Nu. 850 Crore for Program Grant (PG), and Rs./Nu. 500 Crore for Economic Stimulus Plan.
- 4. As on date, Government of India has released Rs./Nu. 2149 Crore for PTA projects, Rs./Nu. 800.15 Crore for SDP and Rs./Nu. 807.5 Crore for Program Grant, and Rs./Nu. 440 Crore for Economic Stimulus Plan to RGoB. In total, GoI has released Rs./Nu. 4197 Crore to RGoB which is 84 % of total GOI commitment for the 11th Five Year Plan Period.
